

## From Narita Airport to the venue

There are two main ways to get to the venue, which is in the Hongo area:



(#1) Take the Skyliner (Keisei line) from Narita Airport to Keisei-Ueno Station. This takes about 1 hour and costs 1,920 yen. From the station, either take a taxi to your hotel or to the Red Gate of the University of Tokyo (about 800 yen). Alternatively, if you don't mind walking a few hundred meters, you can take the Oedo Line subway from Ueno-okachimachi to Hongo-sanhome (160 yen). This alternative is not recommended if you have a large amount of luggage. However, if you decide you can manage the walk, we suggest that you carefully check one of the maps that can be found in Keisei-Ueno Station.

(#2) Take the Narita Express (JR line) from Narita Airport to Tokyo Station. This takes about 1 hour and costs about 3,000 yen. Then take the Marunouchi Line subway from Tokyo Station to Hongo-sanhome Station, which takes about 10 minutes and costs 160 yen.

### Getting around the venue (from subway stations to the office and hall)

Here we assume that you leave the train at Hongo-sanhome Station, although you could get off at other subway stations in the Hongo area, such as Nezu and Todaimae.



(Subway station->Red Gate) From Hongo-sanhome Station go along Hongo-dori Street toward the University of Tokyo. About 350 meters after passing the police box (*KOBAN* in Japanese) you will see on the right-hand side of the street the so-called Red Gate (*Aka-Mon* in Japanese) of the University of Tokyo. It resembles an old entrance to a temple and is colored brown. This is one of the entrances to the Hongo Campus of the University and one of the ways to reach the Sanjo Conference Hall. (However, you can also enter the campus by the main gate, which is 300 meters further along Hongo-dori Street.)



(Red Gate -> the Office) If you do not go in through the Red Gate, keep walking a further 50 meters along Hongo-dori Street until you see, at the end of a short cul-de-sac to your left, a white three-story building (see the map). The *ERATO Quantum Computation and Information Project* office is on the second floor.

(Red Gate-> Sanjo Hall) After entering the campus by the Red Gate, walk straight ahead for about 100 meters until you reach a garden. Turn left in front of the garden, and proceed on paved roads along the edge of a forest. Keeping the forest on your right for a few hundred meters, turn right at the northern end of the forest to a downhill slope, then right again after another few hundred meters. You will then see the Sanjo Hall on the uphill slope, adjacent to the eastern edge of the forest.
