Instructions for Oral Presentation

Equipments

- One screen.
 - An Overhead Projector.
 - A Data Projector. High resolution over 1024×768 is NOT available.
- A laptop PC with PowerPoint 2003 English version.
 - However, we recommend to use your own laptop PC.
- No white or black board.

Time Allocation

- Keynote talk: 50 min. (presentation: 40 min. + discussion: 10 min.)
 - No bell will be used.
- Invited talk: 40 min. (presentation: 35 min. + discussion: 5 min.)
 - No bell will be used.
- Contributed talk: 20 min. (presentation: 15 min. + discussion: 5 min.)
 - A bell will ring at 12 min. (one bell) and 15 min. (two bells).

- Posters are assigned consecutive numbers from 1 to 59. Please consult the program.
